



Employer Matching Frequently Asked Questions

- **What is a matching gift?**

A matching gift represents a corporation's philanthropic interest to support the charities to which its employees contribute. Some Employers have matching gift programs as a benefit to their employees, including in most cases, part time and retired employees. If you are unsure if your employer matches, please contact them to find out.

- **What donations are eligible for matching?**

Each company has its own rules regarding company matching, so please contact your employer to find out their process and what is required. Lacy Foundation is a registered 501c3 charity.

- **My company matches charitable donations, now what?**

Check with your employer to find out what is required. Usually you will need to complete a form from your company that accompanies your donation. Lacy Foundation will follow up with your employer directly and provide what is needed which usually includes a copy of the donor's check, a copy of our 501c3 tax-exempt determination letter, federal tax ID number, and complete any necessary paperwork. We usually do not need to involve you in this part of the process.
